Evelyn Clark Designs . . .

Named for a Seattle bay, this reversible scarf was inspired by a scalloping lace in Barbara Aytes' 1968 book Adventures in Knitting. Elongated stitches are created on Row 1 with yarn-overs that are dropped on Row 2. Directions give three widths and all look great in fuzzy fingering and lace weight yarns, such as Icelandic wool and mohair.

Blocked Sizes

7, 10, or 13" (18, 25.5, or 33 cm) wide, and 60" (152.5 cm) long

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 39 (51, 63) stitches (or any multiple of 12 + 3 stitches). Set-up Rows 1 & 2: knit across. Start Shell & Wave Lace.

Shell & Wave Lace

Row 1 (RS): (k1, yo) to last st, k1. (77, 101, 125 sts)

Row 2 (WS): dropping all yo's from Row 1, k1, slip next 4 sts purlwise, return to holding needle, and k4tog, [(yo, k1) 5 times, yo, slip next 7 sts purlwise, return to holding needle and k7tog], repeat between brackets 2 (3, 4) times, (yo, k1) 5 times, yo, slip next 4 sts purlwise, return to holding needle and k4tog, k1. (39, 51, 63 sts)


Rows 3, 4, 5, & 6: knit across.

Work Rows 1–6 60 times, or to desired length, ending with Row 5.

Final Row 6 (WS) Elastic Cast-off: k2, *transfer the 2 sts back to holding needle and k2tog through back loops, k1,* and repeat between *s across.

Weave in yarn ends, and block, shaping scallops at ends.

Widest size knit with Rowan Kidsilk Haze Stripe lace weight yarn, color SH 00202.

Yarn Requirements

310, 400, or 460 yds (283, 366, or 450 m) fingering or lace weight yarn

Needle Size & Gauge

US size 4 (3.5 mm) needles (or size for desired results), and gauge of 22 sts = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette stitch.
